This non-invasive procedure allows Dr. Tufte a much broader and more detailed view of the retina that is possible with conventional methods. It may also allow you to avoid the blurry vision and light sensitivity associated with having your eyes dilated unless there is a medical issue that Dr. Tufte feels requires dilation. This scan becomes a permanent part of our medical file, enabling Dr. Tufte to make important comparisons should potential vision threatening conditions show themselves at a future examination. Dr Tufte strongly believes that the **Optomap** retinal exam is an essential part of your comprehensive eye exam and suggest it for all patients once per year. If you have questions regarding the **Optomap** retinal scan Dr. Tufte or his technician will be happy to answer them for you.

There is a \$40.00 fee for the Optomap which is due at time of service.
